NOMINATION & APPLICATION

EXCHANGE STUDENTS (Student Visa Type: **D-2-6**)

Hongik University is delighted to host exchange students from partner universities. Duration of the exchange program is generally one semester (admission can be granted for up to one year).

Applicants of UNDERGRADUATES from partner universities are acceptable only.

Master's or higher level students from partner universities are exceptively acceptable, only if they have advanced level on Korean proficiency, and have no difficulty attending graduate courses in Korean.

VISITING STUDENTS (Student Visa Type: D-2-8)

Students who are not from partner universities are welcome to study at Hongik University as visiting students. Duration of the visiting program is generally one semester (admission can be granted for up to one year).

Applicants of UNDERGRADUATES are acceptable only. Master's or higher level students are exceptively acceptable, only if they have advanced level on Korean proficiency, and have no difficulty attending graduate courses in Korean.

Application Deadline

- for the Fall Semester: May 31

Required Documents

- Completed *Application for Study Abroad Program (Visiting Student)*
- Original Statement of Purpose (self-introduction with a study plan)
- Original Recommendation Letter from a faculty of the home institution
- Original Official Transcript from the home institution
- Original Certificate of Enrollment from the home institution
- Original Certificate of High School Graduation
 - Applicants must submit the Original Certificate of Enrollment and the Original Certificate of High School Graduation with either an Apostille verification or a confirmation by the Korean Consul in the country where the home university and high school belong.
 - Applicants whose home university and/or high school is in China must can submit the Original Certificate of Enrollment and/or Original Certificate of High School Graduation issued by CHSI (China Higher Education Student Information).
- Original Proof of Financial Ability (Bank account balance certificate issued within 14 days from the date of application)
 - A certificate of bank deposit balance equivalent to at least KRW10,892,000 for the one-semester program
 - A certificate of bank deposit balance equivalent to at least KRW20,000,000 for the one-year program
 - Bank account holder must be either the applicant or the applicant's parent. In case of submitting the applicant's parent's document, a Family Relations Certificate must be attached.
- Copy of valid passport (first two pages with personal information)
- Portfolio (Art&Design, Architecture related majors only)
- Application Fee KRW100,000 (non-refundable, the net remittance amount must be KRW 100,000, EXCLUDING REMITTANCE FEES)
